Who We Are

Newman Regional Health Inpatient Medical Rehabilitation is a trained rehabilitation team consisting of Physicians, Nurses, Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, and Speech Therapists.

Comprehensive evaluations are completed by each therapist.

Daily supervision is provided by a physician with specific experience in rehabilitation medicine.

Around-the-clock specialized rehabilitation nursing care is present.

Social services are available to assist in discharge planning that may include a home evaluation.

Physical Therapy – Improving the patient’s functional ability to a level that will allow for the most productive lifestyle

Occupational Therapy – Providing care for people of all ages, from pediatrics to older adults, to help achieve the highest level of independence possible

Social Work – Educating patients about their recovery process, coordinating discharge, planning aftercare, and providing support to the patient and their family

Rehab Nursing – Maximizing function while assisting clients with their altered lifestyle in an environment adapted to the patient’s development

Nutrition – Restoring a healthy body weight for the patient by improving eating behaviors

Speech Therapy – Providing treatment, support, and care for children and adults who may experience difficulty while communicating
